Dr. Chatterjee is currently Professor and Chair of the Department of Pediatrics at the University of South Dakota Sanford School of Medicine. She also serves as Senior Associate Dean of Faculty

Development. Dr. Chatterjee was recently elected Steering Committee Chair of the Association of American Medical Colleges Group on Women in Medicine and Science, which advocates for women’s advancement and leadership in the field of academic medicine.

Dr. Chatterjee received her MBBS (MD) from the Armed Forces Medical College at Pune University in India and her PhD at University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha. She completed a residency in pediatrics, followed by a fellowship in pediatric infectious diseases at Creighton University/ University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha.

She has published over 60 peer-reviewed articles, 17 book chapters and has edited one book. She also serves as a reviewer for over 30 journals and is a frequent lecturer and presenter.
